In the last quarter, several anticipated and important developments have taken place for the ROM<sup>3</sup> project. With the help of Lathrop & Gage Law Firm-KC, Brainchild LLC., has filed the necessary documents needed to obtain International Patent protect for ROM<sup>3</sup>. The patent covers several aspects of the device and is protected in several countries in which the laws can be enforced effectively.

As mentioned in the previous newsletter, Dr Johnson met with Dr. Donnelly, KU Medical Center, to begin planning for a National Institute of Health (NIH) Small Business Innovative Research (SBIR) grant application. The case studies needed to substantiate the ROM<sup>3</sup> concept are nearing completion and should be done early this spring. The results are very close to what we expected and we are very excited to be able to move ahead with our application for the grant.

In the mean time, Dr. Johnson has been presenting the preliminary results before several groups of medical professionals in the region. These groups include doctors at the Kansas City Orthopedic Institute (KCOI), the University of Kansas Orthopedic group and the Kansas Arthritic Foundation. Dr. Johnson is also scheduled to appear at the 2005 Big Sky Sports Medicine Athletic Training Conference to present information about Rehab Advancements for ACL and Knee Replacements using the ROM<sup>3</sup> as an exhibit. The Conference will be held at the Big Sky Resort in Big Sky, Montana. In December, 2004, Dr. Johnson signed a contract with the Mid-America Manufacturing Technology Center (MAMTC) to redesign the push-pin release mechanism of the ROM<sup>3</sup> pedals. MAMTC helps small and medium sized businesses with their technological needs at below market rates. Mr. Paul Herring, one of MAMTC's field engineer estimated that it would take about three weeks from start to finish to complete the new design. After which, the new pedal can be manufactured as part of the improved ROM<sup>3</sup>. This won't be the first that MAMTC has worked with Dr. Johnson. A couple of years ago, Mr. Herring worked with Dr. Johnson in helping design the original ROM<sup>3</sup> design.
